Rabbi Ariel Ya'akov Dunat



Rabbi Ariel Ya'akov Dunat is a proud midwestern native, born and raised in Dayton, Ohio. Rabbi Dunat received their undergraduate degrees in French and Comparative Religious Studies from Wright State University before moving to New York City to pursue rabbinic ordination at the Jewish Theological Seminary, also receiving a master's degree in Halakhah and Rabbinic Literature.

Rabbi Dunat is impassioned about halakhah and its relationship with the multifaceted identities we hold as individuals. For the past four years, they have served on the steering committee of the Trans Halakha Project, authoring two responsa on conversion and reproduction within the LGBTQA community.

In addition to this work, Rabbi Dunat is a certified shochet—an expert in kosher slaughter, bringing a commitment to ethical practice, sustainability, and egalitarian values to the kosher world.

Rabbi Dunat has been deeply engaged in communities across the U.S. and Israel—as a sheliach tzibbur, gabbai, leyner, teacher, and volunteer. Alongside halakhah, they have a love for liturgy and theology, using both as tools for connection, meaning-making, and spiritual care.

Rabbi Dunat lives in Washington Heights with their husband, Jason, and shih tzu, Jacques. Together, they enjoy cooking, hosting friends for meals and board games, and exploring their local area—especially its historic and cultural landmarks.




